Bidders are advised to regularly check the website for updates, including any amendments to the terms and conditions and notifications regarding the award of the contract.
- **2. EMD:** Bidders must submit and EMD of **INR 1,00,000**/- (Rupees One Lakh only) in the form of DD/Banker's Cheque or a Bank Guarantee from a schedule commercial bank, valid for at least 150 days in the favor of Mission Director, Meghalaya State Bamboo Mission, MBMA, Payable at Shillong, Meghalaya. Original copy of the EMD must be submitted along with the RFB.
- **3. Bid Submission:** The bidders can submit their bid in Hard Copy at the O/o MegARISE, RDL Building, Springside, Lumsohphoh Nongthymmai, Shillong- 793014. All the documents in compliance with the RFB including the financial bid should be submitted in a Single Envelope.
- **4. Place of Delivery:** One unit will be delivered to each of these locations **1**. Umsli, Bhoirymbong Block, Ri Bhoi District, Meghalaya **2.** Tikrikilla, West Garo Hills District, Meghalaya.

#### 5. Bid Price

- a) The goods/services offered should be 100% of the requirement for the quoted amount. Corrections, if any, shall be made by crossing out, initialling, dating and re writing.
- b) All duties, taxes and other levies payable on the raw materials and components shall be included in the total price.
- c) Goods and Service Tax (GST) should be indicated separately.
- d) The rates quoted by the bidder is inclusive of Supply, Installation, Training and Commissioning including initiation of process for carbon credits accrual, customisation of App etc., and shall be fixed for the duration of the contract and shall not be subject to adjustment on any account.
- e) The Prices shall be quoted in Indian Rupees only.
- f) Bidder must expressly mention the name/brand of the items offered by them in the price schedule along with proper product brochures.
- g) The bidder must mention in details about the product being offered in lieu of the specified specifications and not by simply mentioning "Complied". Such bids with no proper details are likely to be disqualified.
- h) Equipment should comply with all relevant environmental and safety standards.
- i) The bidder shall also provide training on the proper usage of the machine upon delivery.
- j) The bidder must include all additional charges, including transportation, installation and commissioning in their bid.

- 7. Validity of Bids: Bids shall remain valid for a period not less than 90 days after the deadline date specified for submission.
- **8.** Evaluation of Bids: The Purchaser will evaluate and compare the bids that are determined to be substantially responsive i.e. which
  - i. Bids submitted by the bidder must be properly signed by the competent authority of the bidder and company stamped on all the pages.
  - ii. Confirm to the terms and conditions and specifications.
  - iii. Any historical information, if required may be asked from the bidders during evaluation of quotes.
- **9. Award of contract:** The Purchaser will issue the supply order to the bidder whose bid has been determined to be substantially responsive and who has offered the lowest evaluated bid price. In case it is found upon evaluation of RFB that two bidders have quoted the same amount in their financial bid then the vendor having highest average financial turnover during the last 3 Financial years shall be awarded the contract. The announcement for this assignment will be published in www.mbda.gov.in
  - a) Notwithstanding the above, the Purchaser reserves the right to accept or reject any bids and to cancel the bidding process and reject all bids at any time prior to the award of contract. The numbers against each item may increase or decrease at the time of issuing the Supply Order.
  - b) The bidder whose bid is accepted will be notified of the issue of Supply Order by the Purchaser prior to expiration of the bid validity period. The terms of the accepted offer shall be incorporated in the supply order (sample form attached).
- **10.** The supplied goods shall be covered under a minimum one (1) year comprehensive commercial warranty/guarantee from the date of delivery and acceptance. The warranty shall cover any manufacturing defects, faulty materials, or workmanship.
- 11. Payments shall be released on completion and subject to acceptance of deliverables including commissioning of the plants and initiation of carbon credit accrual process, training etc., by the client within 30 working days. However, for any issues experienced post completion and acceptance of the work the purchaser, the vendor should provide support in resolving the technical issues. No Advance payment shall be made.
- 12. The bid shall include provision for training and after-sales support for the operational staff.
- **13.** Sealed bids must reach latest by 1600 hours on 1<sup>st</sup> August, 2025. Bids that have been submitted on or before this time will be opened at 1630 hours on 1<sup>st</sup> August, 2025. Late bids will be rejected.
